Re:2009 Audt of Australian Quality Training Framework (AQTF) Essential Standards for Registration of Training Organisations

In accordance with section 4.3.16 of the *Education and Training Reform Act,* the VRQA granted registration to Arbortrim Australia Pty Ltd on the condition that your organisation would maintain compliance with the Standards. An audit of your compliance with the Standards was conducted on behalf of the VRQA on 6 May 2009. A copy of this report is attached for your information.

In relation to the AQTF Standards, the report indicates a number of areas of noncompliance with Standards 1 and 2. On the basis of the evidence reviewed at audit, the issues of non-compliance are considered to be significant because of the potential to have an adverse impact on learner outcomes.

The VRQA has made the decision to extend your registration for a period of 12 months until 31 May 2010 on the requirement that you commit to rectifying the non-compliances found during audit. In your email dated 29 May 2009 you requested a 3 month extension to your registration, outlining your reasons for this request. On this basis you are required by 28 August 2009 to provide an action plan which outlines any action that you have taken or intend to take to address the findings of the audit report including the date by which all outstanding issues will be addressed.

If any further audits are required to confirm compliance with the requirements of registration a VRQA auditor will be referred to your organisation to conduct a verification audit in line with your action plan. The fee for this will be \$125 per hour plus reasonable travel and other expenses. The outcome of the audit would determine whether any further action will be required.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the RTO ensures that all trainers and assessors hold the required qualifications, cu"ent vocational competence and that staff records include evidence of the qualifications completed.		
Element 1.5 Quality of assessment.		
The RTO did not have, or implement, a strategy for recognition of prior learning. Assessment tools were not avalable for RTF3713A. The assessment tools for RTF3019A, did not		
include complete guideines for candidates and assessors on the conduct of assessment, including guidelines for assessors on the basis of their judgments of competence to ensure consistency of assessment.
