Entry Requirements

To be selected for entry into AHC30816 Certificate III in Arboriculture, applicants are required to complete a suitability review, a task participation and medical checklist and a language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) evaluation, prior to enrolment. Applicants must also be currently employed within the arboriculture industry and be able to demonstrate either:

- The completion of AHC20516 Certificate II in Arboriculture or equivalent; or
- · A minimum of 12 months' relevant industry experience

As this qualification includes a Licence to Perform High Risk Work (EWP), the applicant must also be over 18 years of age and hold current government issued photo identification.

¹Tree climbing add-on

AHCARB312 - Use standard climbing techniques to access trees is offered as an added option for those participants that want to become climbing arborists.

This nationally accredited unit will be delivered alongside your AHC30816 - Certificate III in Arboriculture qualification. It is an industry requirement that assessment for this unit must include a log record of 200 hours of standard climbing.

This unit has a pre-requisite.
