#### Entry Requirements

To be selected for entry into AHC30816 Certificate III in Arboriculture, applicants are required to complete a suitability review, a task participation and medical checklist and a language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) evaluation, prior to enrolment. Applicants must also be currently employed within the arboriculture industry and be able to demonstrate either:

- The completion of AHC20516 Certificate II in Arboriculture or equivalent; or
- A minimum of 12 months' relevant industry experience

As this qualification includes a Licence to Perform High Risk Work (EWP), the applicant must also be over 18 years of age and hold current government issued photo identification.

#### <sup>1</sup>Tree climbing add-on

**AHCARB312 - Use standard climbing techniques to access trees** is offered as an added option for those participants that want to become climbing arborists.

This nationally accredited unit will be delivered alongside your AHC30816 - Certificate III in Arboriculture qualification. It is an industry requirement that assessment for this unit must include a log record of 200 hours of standard climbing.

This unit has a pre-requisite.
