### Entry Requirements

To be selected for entry into AHC30820 Certificate III in Arboriculture (Elevated Work Platform – EWP Arborist) applicants are required to complete a suitability review, a task participation and medical checklist and a language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) evaluation, prior to enrolment.

#### Applicants must also:

- Be currently employed within the arboriculture industry
- Be over 18 years of age, reside in Victoria and hold current government issued photo identification as this qualification includes a Licence to Perform High Risk Work (EWP); and
- Be able to demonstrate completion of HLTAID009 - Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (or) confirm enrolment into HLTAID009 - Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (which is required as a pre-requisite unit for one of the selected units of competency)
- Have access to a laptop computer
