FWPC0T2273 - Trim and cut felled trees

AHCMOM213 - Operate and maintain chainsaws

This course is suitable for both experienced and non-experienced chainsaw operators. It has been designed to develop or increase skills in operating chainsaws safely and efficiently in a range of common work situations including when trimming and cutting felled trees.

Course includes:

- Chainsaw Safety workplace health and safety, hazard and risk management and PPE selection and use.
- Chainsaw Preparation and Maintenance cleaning and maintaining chainsaws including chain tensioning and chain sharpening.

This 2 day nationally accredited course develops the skills required to assess, plan and safely carry out manual tree-felling operations using a chainsaw. It covers procedures for felling 'basic' trees, i.e. single stem or non-complex multi-stem sound trees.

Chainsaw Level 3

FWPCOT3347 - Fell trees manually (intermediate)

This course includes the outcomes required to assess, plan and safely carry out manual tree-felling operations using a chainsaw. This course covers the felling procedures for trees with a level of complexity that requires significant tree assessment and practical felling skills. Persons assessed as competent in this unit should be able to effectively fell most trees except very large trees and/or those with significant defects and/or characteristics that cause excessive complexity. This course applies to felling trees that have a diameter greater than the bar length of the chainsaw.

This course requires the operator to plan the work, conduct routine checks, set up elevating work platform, operate elevating work platform and shut down and secure elevating work platform. Successful students receive a WorkSafe Victoria Notice of Assessment that must be lodged with WorkSafe to obtain the High Risk Work licence.

UETDRMP005 - Perform EWP rescue

This course covers the performance of rescue procedures from an elevating work platform (EWP) and the performance of elevated work platform (EWP) controlled descent escape procedures. It specifies the mandatory requirements for self rescue from a raised EWP and how they apply in the context of transmission, distribution or rail work functions. It encompasses responsibilities for, health, safety and risk management processes at all operative levels and adherence to safety practices as part of the normal way of doing work.

This is a basic climbing course that is designed to provide the skills and knowledge required to access trees for inspection. It does not include all of the skills and knowledge required to access trees to conduct arboriculture work, tree pruning and removal. This course may be suitable for persons conducting tree inspections, habitat installation, ecological surveys, seed collection and other arboreal activities. This course also includes tying, dressing, setting and finishing climbing knots and hitches.

Advanced Climbing

AHCARB319 - Use arborist climbing techniques

This course is designed to provide the skills and knowledge required to climb trees with ropes, harnesses and specialist equipment using climbing techniques for the purpose of mobility in the canopy of trees to acquire a safe work position. This course also includes tying, dressing, setting and finishing climbing knots and hitches.

- · Descending from a tree and installing a throwline
- Branch walking

Aerial Rescue

AHCARB318 - Undertake aerial rescue

This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to perform an aerial rescue where an injured or trapped climber is safely brought to ground from the tree. It is likely to be undertaken in an emergency situation. The unit applies to individuals who work in arboriculture under broad direction and take responsibility for their own work.

- · Assess casualty condition and system integrity
